A Time for Prayer! Read: Ecclesiastes 3:1-8, 2nd Peter 3:8-9, and Ephesians 5:15-20

It is hard to believe that summer is just around the corner, especially with all the cold weather and snow we had in April. April is now behind us (hopefully the cold weather is too) and we are stepping into the month of May. So where has time gone? It seems like yesterday that Jacob and Lori were just little children playing in the sandbox. Now, they are both married and I have a grandbaby. Where has time gone? As I stop to reflect on my life, I pull myself away from my "busy-ness"... that which eats up my minutes and hours and sometimes my days and months and years... sometimes I am so busy that I don't even see life passing me by so quickly. I always try to stop for a moment each day to look, to listen, and observe the activities going on around me. But sometimes it is like being at the race track watching the cars zoom by...they are going so fast everything is a blur. Life is like that sometimes. People always say that one will find time for what one really wants to do. That is true. If you want to have time with God, you will find or make the time to do so. The only way you will ever build a relationship with God is by investing time in prayer. I encourage you to make time for God in your life, every day...after all, isn't that why we were created...to fellowship with God? Our "busy-ness" will not bring us peace or joy. Our "busy-ness" will not sustain us in hard times, our "busy-ness" will not comfort us in times of sadness, or encourage us when we are weak, or empower us to face the challenges of the day... but God can and will give us peace and joy, comfort and courage, and empower us for the trials of each new day. So, how will you spend your time today... tomorrow... and in the days ahead.?


