Where Has Time Gone?

Read: Ecclesiastes 3:1-8, 2 Peter 3:8-9, Ephesians 5:15-20

It is hard to believe that summer is almost here. April is history...where has time gone? It seems like yesterday that Jacob and Lori were just little children. Now, Jacob is married with a child of his own and Lori is married and living in Seattle. Where has time gone? As I stop to reflect, I pull myself away from my "busy-ness"... that which eats up my minutes and hours and sometimes my days and months and years. Sometimes I am so busy that I don't even see life passing me by so quickly. I always try to stop for a moment each day to look, to listen, and observe the activities going on around me. However, I must admit that sometimes I can't step out of the "busy-ness" and I miss the sunrise, the sunset, the birds singing, the children laughing, the warmth of the sun, the sound of the rain, the cool breeze... How about you? Do you ever go to bed wondering where the day went? Do you ever wish that you would have spent your time differently?

Time is our gift from God. What we do with that time is our gift to God. I try to tithe my time to God, giving him a portion of each day. That would be 2 hours and 40 minutes. Oh yes, I hear you saying, "Where am I going to find the time to give God 2 hours and 40 minutes of each day?" Stop for a minute. Think about how you used your time today or yesterday. How much time did you spend in your car? In front of the Television? Listening to music? Playing video games? Sitting in front of your computer? Waiting in a doctor's office? Washing dishes? Mowing the grass? Cleaning the house, the car, the yard? I often pray when I am driving. I can pray when I am listening to music, when I am cooking dinner, when I am eating... I think you get the point. There is so much time that slips away from us that we could give to God, but don't. In order to give God a tithe of our time we must be intentional about finding the time, making the time, and using the time for that purpose...looking and longing for it just as we would if we were searching for a great treasure. It is said that people find time for what they really want to do. That is true. If you want to have time with God, you will find or make the time to do so.

I encourage you to make time for God in your life, every day...after all, isn't that why we were created...to fellowship with God? Our "busy-ness" will not bring us peace or joy. Our "busy-ness" will not sustain us in hard times, our "busy-ness" will not comfort us in times of sadness, or encourage us when we are weak, or empower us to face the challenges of the day... but God can and our time with God will give us peace and joy, comfort and courage, and empower us for the trials of each new day. So, how will you spend your time today?
