One of my favorite artists is El Greco. I love his elongated figures. I love religious icons too and the carved statues of the Greek Period. There are interesting stories about many of the world’s famous artists, like Adolph Menzel who was a self-taught artist. His father wanted him to become a University Professor but he could not get Adolph to put his love for drawing aside to do so. He became a very famous and sought-after artist...even by royalty like King Frederick. In the Berlin art gallery there once hung an unfinished picture by Menzel of Frederick the Great talking to his generals. There was a small bare patch in the center of the picture where a charcoal sketch indicated the artist’s intentions. He had painted in all the generals and all the other details of the picture, but Menzel left the king to paint last. That is so true to our lives too... we carefully put in all the generals and leave the King for last... we fit everything else into our lives that we want to do or achieve and leave God and our spiritual needs for last. Poor Menzel died before he found time to finish his picture; the King never found completion in the center of his picture. I am sure that Menzel had every good intention of painting the King... someday. We too have every good intention of putting King Jesus in the center of our lives... someday. I was told once that the road to hell is paved with good intentions. Maybe it is... And if it is, maybe it is time to stop just thinking about putting God first in your life and just doing it. Now is the time to give God the place he deserves... first place in the center of your heart and lives. Today, not tomorrow... Don’t wait... Like Menzel...tomorrow it might be too late!

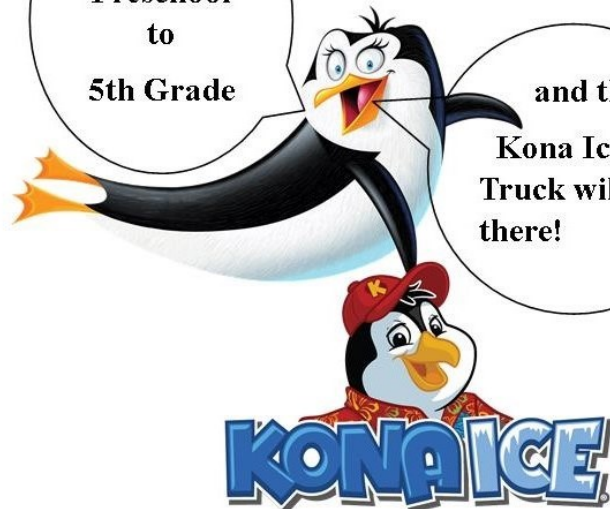

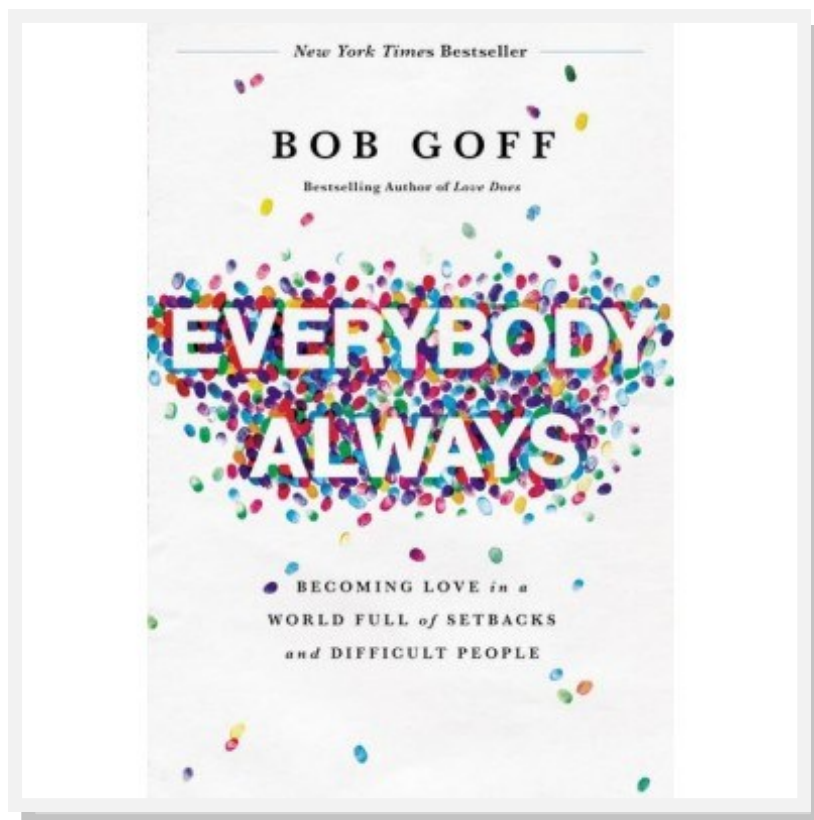
The children sang “Mommy Loves Me” for Mother’s Day. Special thanks to Carrie Byerly and Angela Heiser for working with the kids.

After our graduation, we had a picnic and fun time at the park.

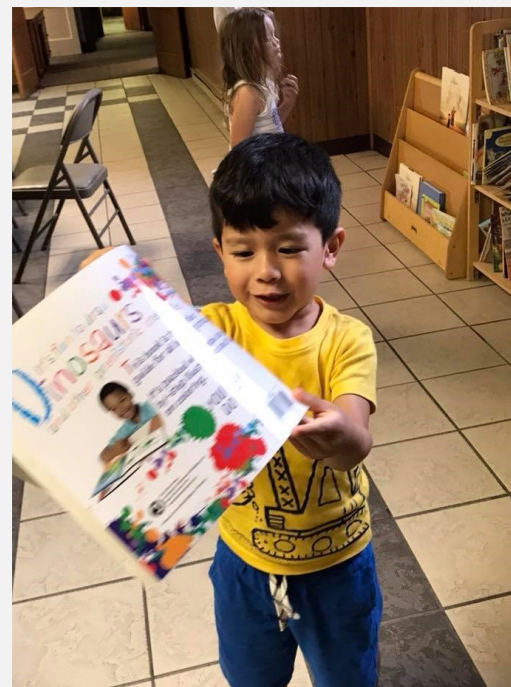




It has been an amazing year. Those who work with these kids will tell you we are truly blessed. God has given us a special ministry.
