Read 1st John 3:2-3 "In the Image of God"

There comes a time in life when we realize that no one is perfect... not even our selves. No matter how hard we try, we will never be "perfect"... at least not by God's standards. Why is it, then, that Jesus tells us in Matthew 5:48, "Be perfect, therefore, as your heavenly Father is perfect."? How can we be perfect when we are so-o-o human? Truly, on our own it's impossible. However, with God's help we can aspire to be as much like Christ as is possible. We must separate ourselves from the world's values and be devoted to God's desires rather than to our own... being "God" focused rather than "self" focused. No one can achieve a Christ-like character or a holy lifestyle overnight...it takes time...a lifetime of growth in Christian maturity. God understands human nature and he extends his grace to cover our imperfections. As we grow in our faith we will become more Christ-like in character. We should never let our tendency to sin deter us from striving to be more like Jesus. The devil would like to see nothing more than someone giving up or spending one's life on an unnecessary guilt trip. God does not expect us to be perfect overnight... remember, God is gracious! At each stage of maturity God has expectations of us to fulfill, just like we do with babies as they become toddlers, teens, and young adults. Babies grow up and so must we. God has a way of refining us to mirror his own image to the world around us. And that is exactly what God expects of mature Christians...we are to be the image of Christ to the world around us. Jesus calls us to excel, to rise above mediocrity, and to mature in every area, becoming like him.

Malachi 3:3 says: 'He will sit as a refiner and purifier of silver." If you have ever watched a silversmith you will know that the silversmith will take a piece of silver and hold it in the middle of the fire where the flames are the hottest so that all the impurities in the silver will burn away. Like the silversmith, God holds us in a spiritual hot spot to help burn away our spiritual impurities...it is not easy for anyone to become Christ-like in character! The Silversmith must sit there in front of the fire the whole time the silver is being refined because he has to keep his eyes on the silver so that when it is purified it can be removed immediately. The silver would be destroyed if it were to stay in the fire too long. Like the silversmith God never takes his eyes off of us as he refines our spirits. How does the silversmith know when the silver is refined? It's very simple. He will see his image in it... God will continue to refine...to make perfect our spirits...until he sees his image in us. If you feel the heat of God's refining fire in your life, remember that God is watching you carefully ...waiting to see his image shine in you.


