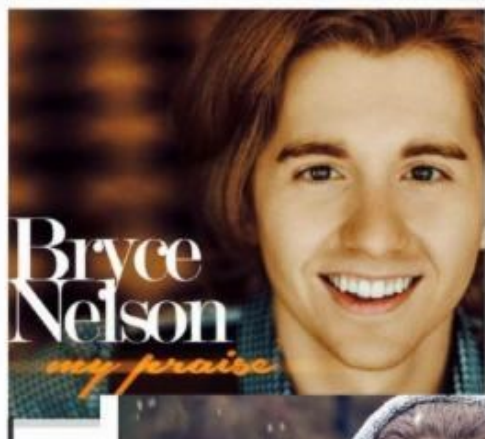


Isaiah 49:16 “Behold, I have carved you on the palms of My hands;”

One of my favorite pictures is Jesus sitting on a hillside overlooking Jerusalem and weeping for them...longing for them to come to him. I truly and completely believe that God is a personal God...who longs to be with his children. After all, he has carved us on the palm of his hands. He is not indifferent or untouchable or far away from humanity. God is near. He is here, with us, every moment of every day. He is with us and for us and his love is everlasting! That is their life choice and this is not to judge or condemn them. It is to contrast that God is not like that...He will never abandon us or neglect us or reject us. His hands are always open to us ready to receive us, to encourage us, to hold us, to carry us through life's ups and downs, through the good days and in days of tragedy. Even when you don't feel God's presence...God's love is constant. Even if you don't feel loveable or worthy of his love...God still loves you. God's love is everlasting. When all else fails and fades...God is still there. God is our rock, our refuge, our stronghold, our comfort, our shield... he is all that we need to see us through this life. His love and mercy are forever!

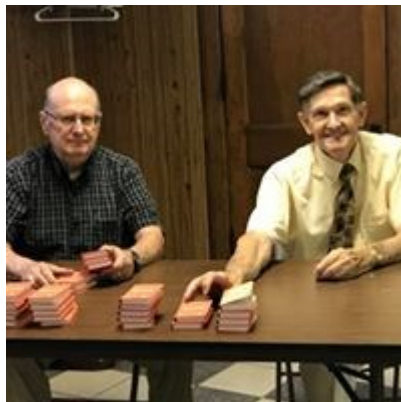
The congregational photo for the Sesquicentennial Celebration is scheduled for Sunday August 26th after the 10:00a.m. worship service.

In Enrichment, we have been studying David from the young boy who slayed Goliath to King David.

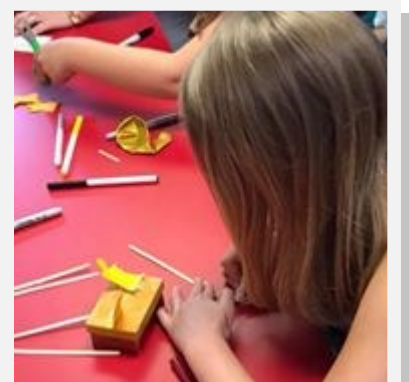

We made King David's crown.

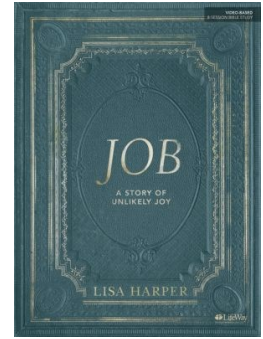
