We will be decorating the church on Sunday, November 19, following worship. There will be soup and sandwiches available for those who stay and help. There will be activities for the kids.




For those who want to make an Advent Wreath during the Hanging of the Greens, please let the church office know you want to make one. We will then have enough supplies available.




### ENRICHMENT
