Mrs. Cathy Good is a retired kindergarten teacher from Sheridan Elementary.

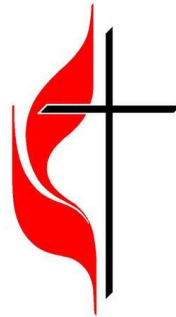

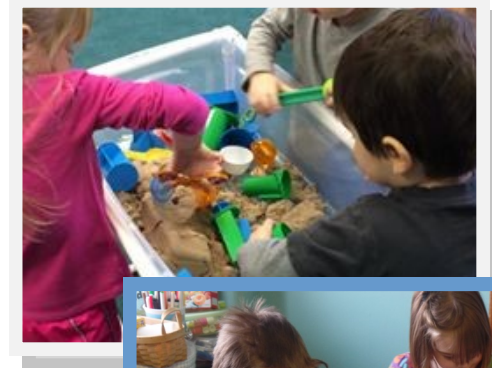

Learn and Play Preschool



Learn and Play is a free preschool program offered through the Sheridan First United Methodist Church as an opportunity for the community of Sheridan.

Learn and Play has an average attendance of 14 children between the ages of 2 and 5. The program is designed to meet once a week for two hours. A parent or grandparent is expected to stay and participate in the experience. Homework is also sent home for the week to encourage parents to continue the learning experience in the home environment.

Mission of the Program

This outreach ministry is designed to provide a free opportunity for preschoolers to obtain a structured learning experience prior to entering kindergarten. The program offers age-appropriate activities that encourage children to learn through play experiences.



Along with the age-appropriate learning, we endeavor to recognize special needs of students and refer students to the appropriate programs. Our teachers were able to recognize that one student qualified for the Headstart program at Sheridan Elementary and assisted in getting the student enrolled.



With support from the local community, we have been able to have the preschoolers eyes checked, receive a visit from the local dentist, and participate in a fire safety lesson given by the Sheridan Fire Department. The older students were privileged to see “Cat in the Hat” at the Booth Tarkington Civic Theatre thanks to their generous support of providing free tickets. Sheridan Community Schools assisted with transportation.
